

CUCRA/CUCEA Meeting, April 26 & 27, via Zoom

Introduction

UC Retirees Travel has completed eight successful trips since the October 2022 meeting—Chile/Argentina (two departures), a Danube River cruise, South Africa, Egypt, Spain/Portugal, and Japan (two departures). As we gain more experience with escorting trips, we can better anticipate the needs of our travelers and provide the services that are most helpful to them.

Publicity

- Continued the monthly *Travel Talk* e-newsletter; started in May 2019 with 689 subscribers; during the last six months, the list has grown from 2,150 subscribers to 2,545 subscribers.
- Continued sending publicity to retiree center directors, CUCRA reps, and New Dimensions editor.
- Continued working with Bob Daly to list and update information on the CUCRA website.
- Offered four webinars: one by Collette, one by OAT, and four by our volunteers for UCSF, UCSD, USB, and UCI retirees.

Management

- Continued working with Dolores Dyer, assistant coordinator, on trip planning and publicity.
- Held monthly Zoom meetings with UC Retirees Travel volunteers (Dolores Dyer, UCLA; Frank Trueba, UCSC; Sandra Norberg, UCSF; Vickie Leow, UCSF) to share successes and brainstorm solutions to challenges. Much of our support is in pre-trip preparations (answering questions and coordinating with tour operators). Once the trips are underway, the escorts provide back-up to the trip leaders, assisting with logistics and group management. While most trips have been problem-free, issues arise, such as interpersonal conflicts between travelers, COVID transmission, and occasional problems with the tour operators' leaders and/or tour logistics. In several instances, the escorts have played essential role in addressing issues on the trips.
